

The Health Policy Institute of Ohio (HPIO) has been commissioned by the Ohio Department of Health to gather stakeholder input for the Maternal and Child Health (MCH) and Maternal, Infant and Early Childhood Home Visiting (MIECHV) five-year assessments.

As part of this project, HPIO facilitated a series of five regional forums in October 2018. These forums included afternoon MCH/MIECHV sessions where participants completed prioritization worksheets for one of five population groups (maternal/women, perinatal/infants, children, children with special health care needs, adolescents/young adults). Stakeholders who completed a worksheet at a regional forum are welcome to complete this survey for population groups other than the one for which they completed their worksheet at the regional forum.
